FIRST WEEK

- To be able to identify the species, explains the law (CITES, European, National).
- where to find important information about law implementation ? To know CITES, European and national laws concerning exotic species.
- Basics husbandry and feeding practice. The trainee is responsible for advising the exotic pet owner about law, husbandry and feeding practice.

SECOND WEEK

- To be able to explain and detect the main mistakes in husbandry: terrarium conception, aquarium maintenance or choice and equipment of cages and aviaries
- To be able to conceive a terrarium or aquarium
- The importance of temperature (hot spot), hygrometry and UVB. The trainee is responsible for conceiving a good habitat for the main exotic species studied

THIRD WEEK

- To be able to feed hospitalized patients and evaluate pain
- How to prepare and check an exotic patient for anesthetic and surgical care
- To be responsible for monitoring the patient during induction, anesthesia and recovery
